

Teaching Fellowship Program 2024

On-campus/Hybrid 2 year full-time program

The Imaad Isaacs Foundation, in partnership and Futures Academy, herewith invite aspirant teachers who have an interest in teaching youth from grades 7-12. Teaching fellowships are available for the 2024 academic year at our partner school in Lansdowne Cape Town.

Fellowship program entails:

- Teaching / co-teaching 3-4 timetabled classes throughout the academic year; including virtual and on-campus classes
- Program is split between fellows in the teaching or teaching and administrative support streams
- Support, guidance and mentoring from a senior teacher and community of peers
- Structured teacher development opportunities including workshops and observations
- Participation in extra-mural activities at either of our partner schools
- Receiving a small monthly stipend
- University (UNISA*) tuition fees paid by the Imaad Isaacs Foundation
 - Fees up to the UNISA fees value if enrolled at another university
- The use of a tablet or a laptop
- Gaining valuable, real teaching experience in a supportive, and innovative environment
- Possibility of employment in 2026 at our partner schools

Requirements - Applicants must

- have completed or be in the final year of completing a bachelor's degree or 3 year diploma;
- be planning to study for their PGCE via distance education in 2024 or;
- be in their 3rd or 4th year of a BEd degree enrolled via distance education
- have an interest in teaching any of the following subjects:
 - Mathematics, Mathematical Literacy, Physical Sciences, English, Business Studies, Computer Applications Technology and Basic Coding, Life Sciences and/or Natural Sciences, Religion Studies, Arabic Language, Afrikaans Home and First Additional Language,
- candidates must have at least one of their interested teaching subjects (from the list above) completed at second- or third-year level; and another at either levels whether on the list or not

- Evidence of application to UNISA or a distance learning university for a PGCE in 2024 or:
- Proof of acceptance to a distance learning PGCE program for 2024 or;
- Proof of current enrollment in a BEd distance education program
- Completed online pre-interview questionnaire;
- A curriculum vitae which includes the names of at least two relevant referees;
- Certified copies of your degree certificates, results/transcripts and ID document; and
- A reference letter written in the last two years
- Currently employed educators and/or graduates may also apply
